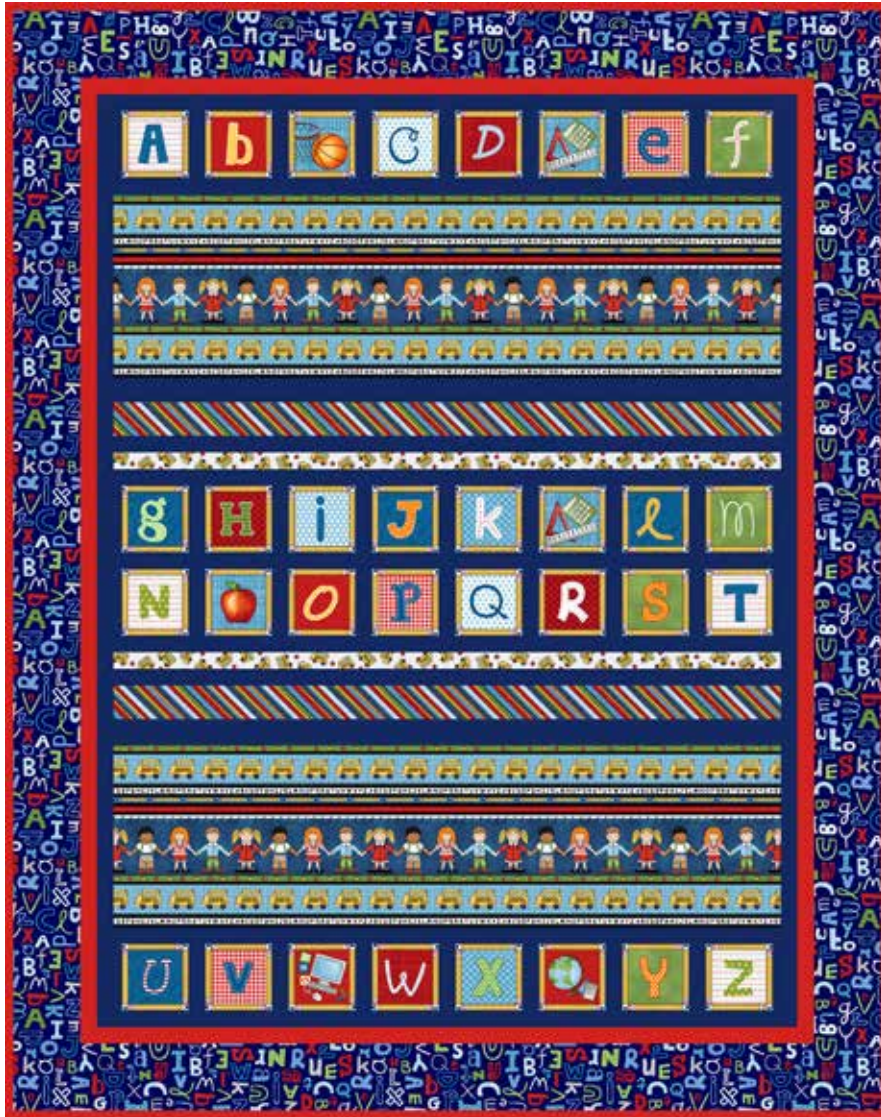

(D) 4139-78 .....	1/4 yard		
(E) 4135-1 .....	1/8 yard	* Includes Binding	
(F) Flame-16** .....	7/8 yard*	** Peppered Cottons Collection	

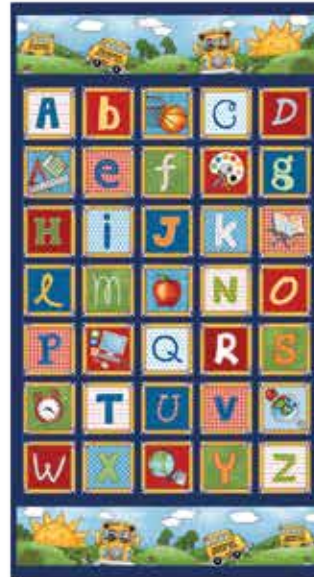

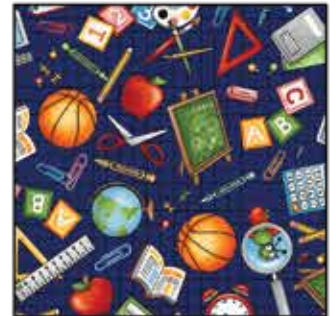

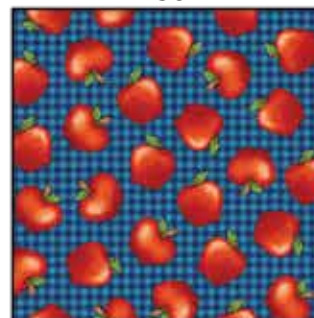

## Cutting

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### **Fabric A (4131P-77 24" Block Panel – Navy):**

- Fussy cut (32) 4 ½" blocks.

#### **Fabric B (Ink-45 Peppered Cottons – Ink), cut:**

- (2) 2" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (48) 2" x 6 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 57 ½" strips.
- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (64) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

#### **Fabric C (4132-77 Border Stripe – Navy):**

- Fussy cut (2) 12" x 40 ½" LOF strips, each centered on a row of children

#### **Fabric D (4139-78 Diagonal Stripe – Multi), cut:**

- (2) 2 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.

#### **Fabric E (4135-1 School Buses All-Over – White), cut:**

- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.

#### **Fabric F (Flame-16 Peppered Cottons – Flame), cut:**

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 57 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### **Fabric G (4136-77 Alphabet All-Over – Navy), cut:**

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 52 ½" strips.

#### **Backing (4133-77 School Icons All-Over – Navy), cut:**

- (2) 60" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 60" x 75" to make the back.

## Sewing

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 blocks total.

2. Sew (8) Unit 1 blocks together to make (1) Section 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Section 1 strip.

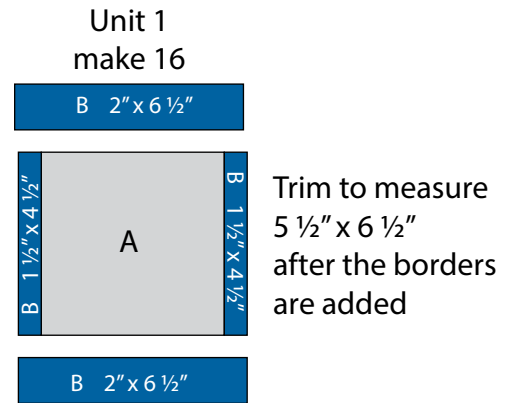

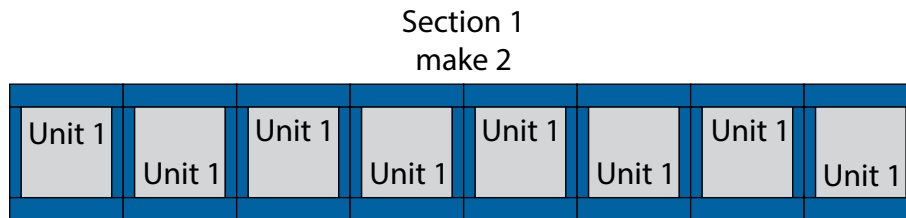

3. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top of the Fabric A block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6$ " to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 blocks total.

4. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top of the Fabric A block. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6$ " to make (1) Unit 3 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 blocks total.

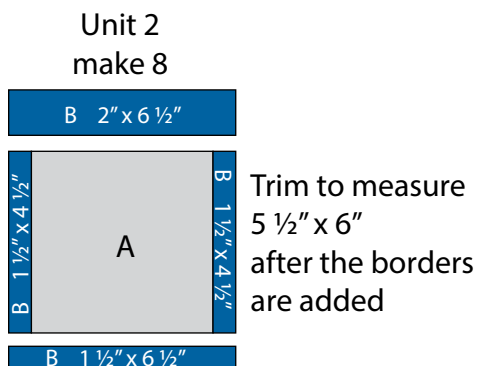

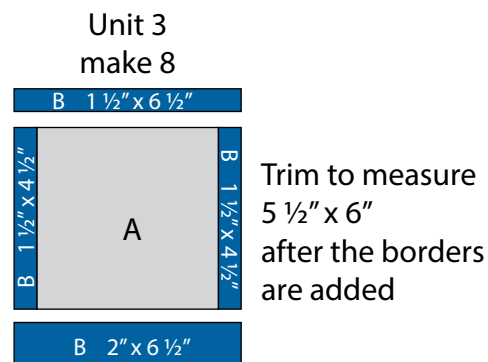

5. Sew (8) Unit 2 blocks together to make (1) strip. Sew (8) Unit 3 blocks together to make (1) strip. Sew the (2) strips together lengthwise to make (1) Section 2 strip.

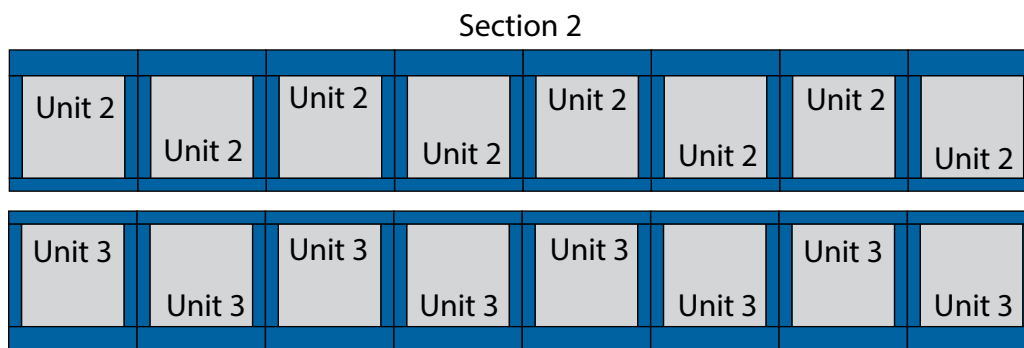

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

6. Sew (1) 2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric D strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip to the bottom of the Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) BDB strip. Repeat to make a second BDB strip.

7. Sew (1) Section 1 strip, (1) 12" x 40 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) BDB strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) Section 2 strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) BDB strip, (1) 12" x 40 1/2" Fabric C strip and (1) Section 1 strip together lengthwise and in that order to make the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 57 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 57 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 59 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

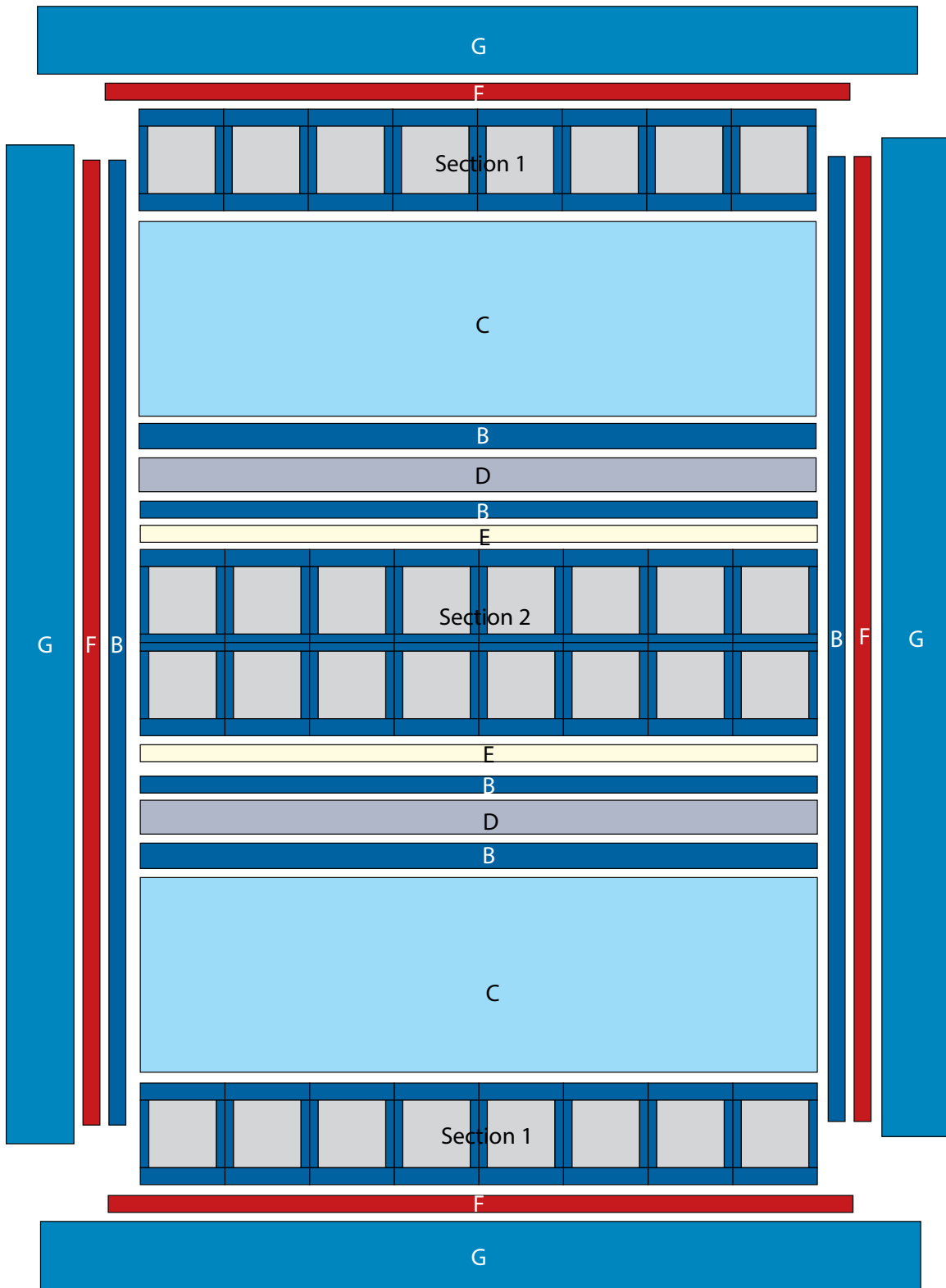
## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

11. Press the quilt top and 60" x 75" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

12. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric F binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

13. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
