Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3853-93 Woodland Animal Patchwork-Gray/Tan):

- Fussy cut (1) 24 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 17" x 24 ½" strip as shown on the cover image.

Fabric B (3858-99 Snowflakes-Black), cut:

- (2) 1 ¼" x 24 ½" strips
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 2" x 18 ½" strips.

Fabric C (3857-90 Winter Owls in Trees-Gray), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 27 ½" strips from the LOF strips.
- (2) 4 ½" x 18 ½" strips from the WOF from the remaining fabric.

Fabric D (3858-90 Snowflakes-Gray), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric E (3858-88 Snowflakes-Red), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 35 ½" strips.
- (2) 1" x 28 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 40 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with a diagonal seam and cut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

Fabric F (3851-98 Winter Woodland Animals-Black/Red), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric G (3855-99 Reindeer in Sweaters-Black), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric H (3856-8 Tossed Owls-Red/White), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric I (3852-8 Pinecones and Berries-Red/White), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (9) 4 ½" squares.

Fabric J (1351-Onyx Just Color!-Onyx), cut:

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing (3852-99 Pinecones and Berries-Black), cut:

- (2) 48" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 48" x 56" back.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

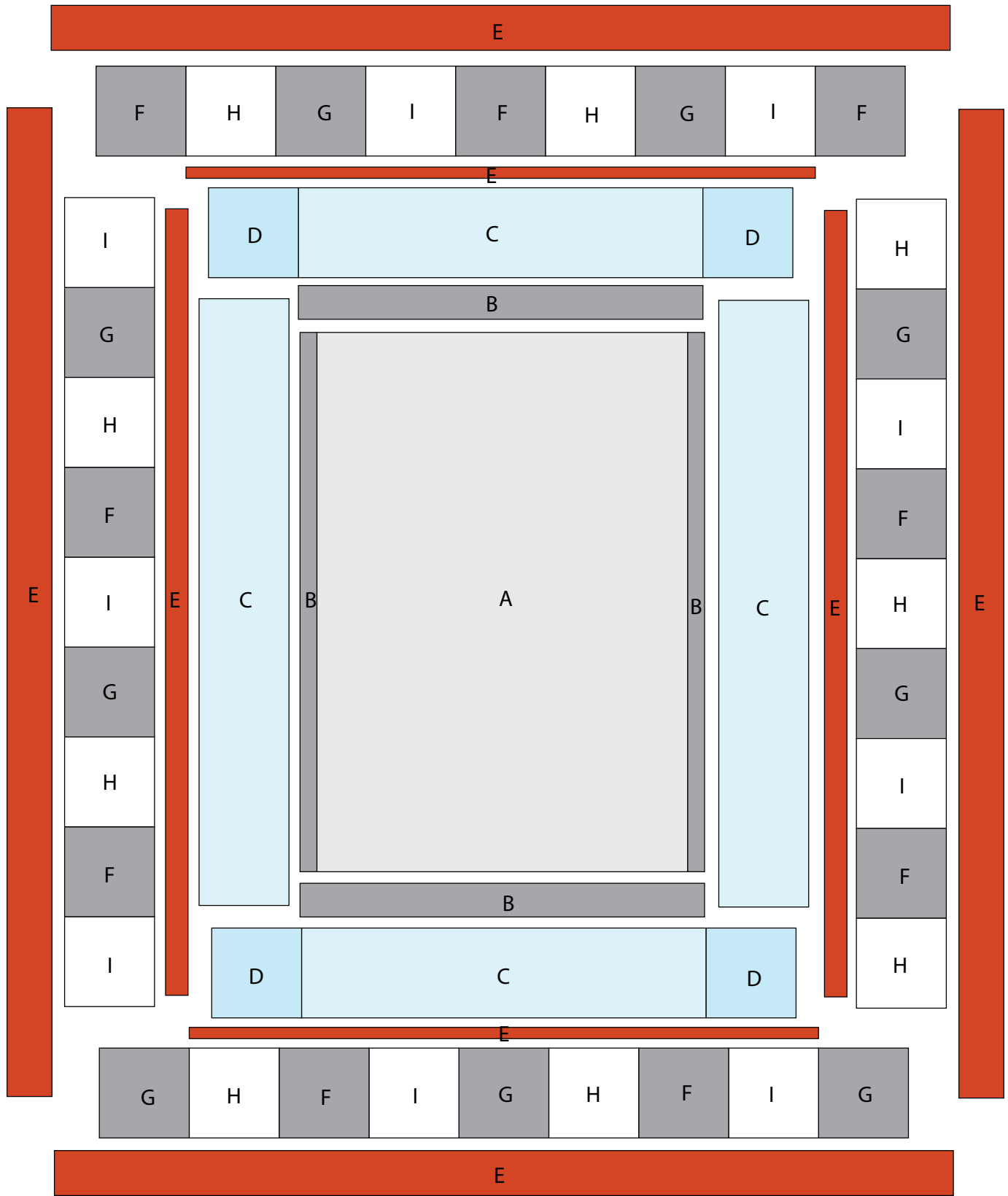
1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 17 " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the center block
2. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the center block. Sew one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to make the top border Repeat to make the bottom borders. Sew the borders to the center block to make the quilt top.
3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 1 " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
4. Sew together (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares, (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares, (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares to make the left side border. Sew the border to the quilt top.
5. Sew together (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares, (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares, (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares to make the right side border. Sew the border to the quilt top.
6. Sew together (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares, (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares, (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares to make the Top border. Sew the border to the quilt top.
7. Sew together (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares, (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares, (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares to make the Bottom border. Sew the border to the quilt top.
8. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

13. Press the quilt top and 48 " x 56 " backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

14. Cut the ends of the (5) Fabric J binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
15. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
