## Cutting

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### **Fabric A (4181P-71 24" Panel – Blue):**

- Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 27 ½" panel.

#### **Fabric B (1351-Pigment White Just Color! – Pigment White), cut:**

- (2) 2 ½" x 27 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 37 ½" WOF strips.

#### **Fabric C (4188-77 Snowflakes – Navy), cut:**

- (4) 3" x WOF strips.

#### **Fabric D (4188-11 Snowflakes – Light Blue), cut:**

- (4) 3" x WOF strips.

#### **Fabric E (4185-77 Fishing Penguins – Navy), cut:**

- (1) 4 ½" strip, sub-cut (4) 4 ½" strips.

#### **Fabric F (4187-71 Knitted Stripe – Blue), cut:**

- (2) 4 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 4 ½" x 37 ½" WOF strips.

#### **Fabric G (1351-Navy Just Color! – Navy), cut:**

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### **Backing (4183-77 Four-Way Multi Animals – Navy), cut:**

- (2) 53" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 53" x 58" to make the back.

## Sewing

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the  $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $26\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure  $25\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) 3" x WOF Fabric C strip and (1) 3" x WOF Fabric D strip together lengthwise to make (1) CD strip set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) CD strip sets total.
3. Cut the (4) CD strip sets into (52) 3" x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 strips (Fig. 3).
4. Sew (2) Unit 1 strips together to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (26) Unit 2 blocks total.

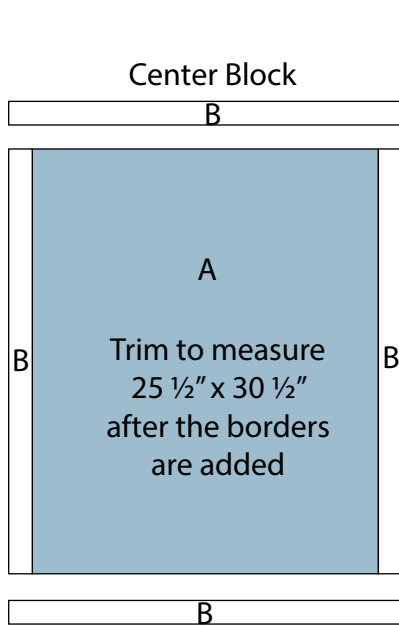

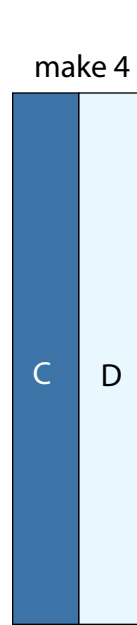

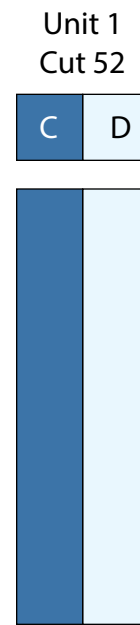

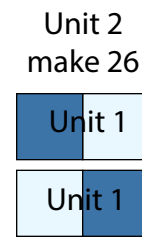

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

5. Sew (6) Unit 2 blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
6. Sew (7) Unit 2 blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $37\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $37\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

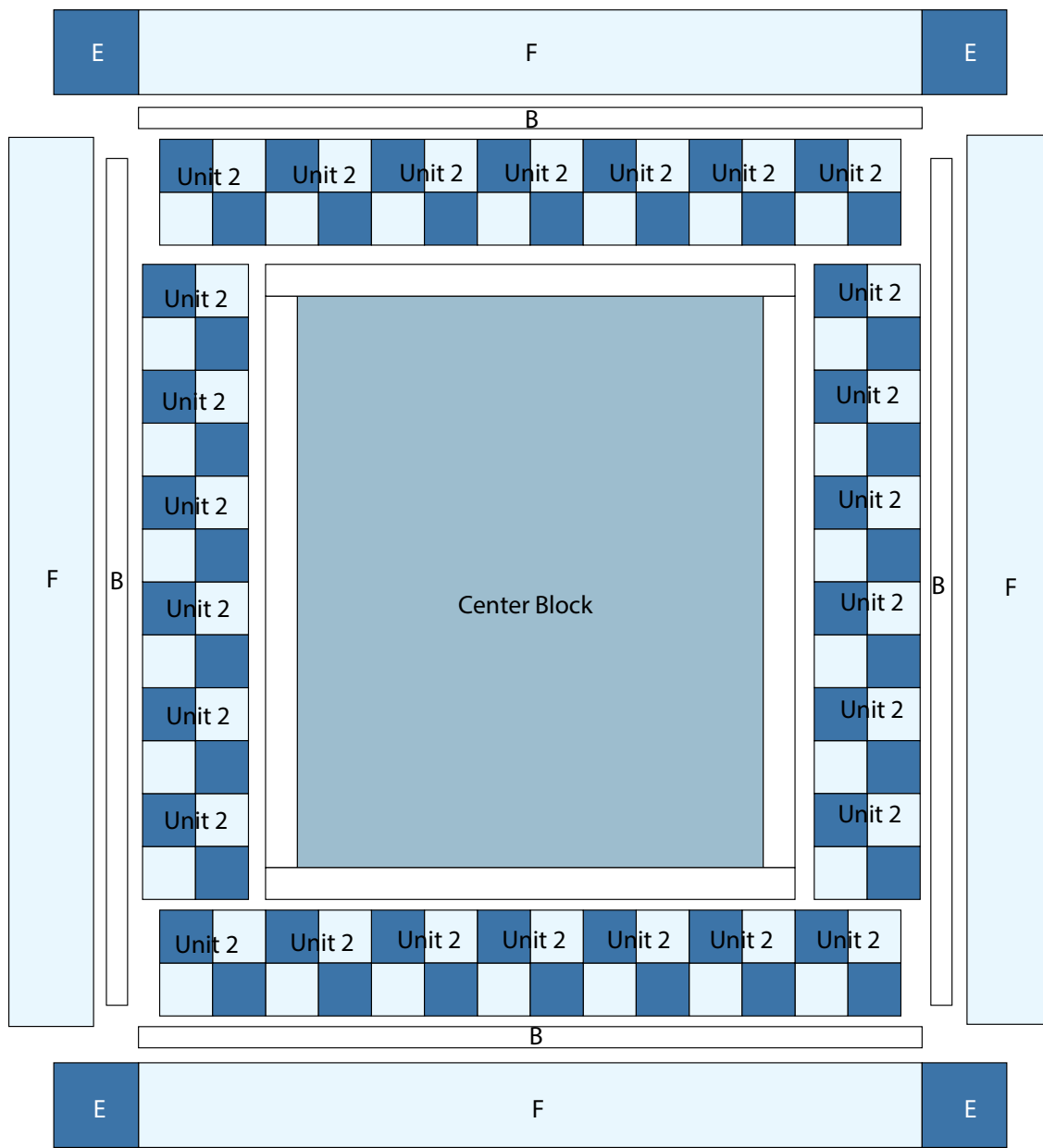
## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

9. Press the quilt top and 53" x 58" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

10. Cut the ends of the (5) Fabric G binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

11. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
