Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (4182-71 Patchwork – Blue), cut:

- (1) 20" x 28 ¼" LOF strip.

Fabric B (4188-77 Snowflakes – Navy), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 51 ¼" strips.
- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 28 ¼" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ¼" x 22" WOF strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 3 ¼" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 5 ¼" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C (4183-90 Four-Way Multi Animals – Light Gray):

- Fussy cut (4) 3 ¼" squares each centered on an animal.

Fabric D (4185-90 Fishing Penguins – Light Gray), cut:

- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strips, sub-cut (8) 3 ¼" squares. Cut (4) squares across one diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Cut the remaining (4) squares across one diagonal from the upper right corner to the lower left corner.
- (4) 5 ¼" x 13 ¾" LOF strips.
- (1) 5 ¼" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 5 ¼" x 8 ⅞" strips.

Fabric E (4184-11 Ice Skaters – Light Blue), cut:

- Fussy cut (4) 3 ½" squares each centered on an animal. From each square, cut (1) 2 ⅜" square on point.

Fabric F (Ink-45 Peppered Cottons – Ink), cut:

- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 1 ¼" x 2 ⅜" strips.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 1 ¼" x 3 ⅞" strips.
- See instruction to cut (4) Snowflakes.

Fabric G (1351-Denim Just Color! – Denim), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 41 ¼" WOF strips.
- (2) 1" x 33 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric H (4187-71 Knitted Stripe – Blue), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 5" squares.

Fabric I (4183-77 Four-Way Multi Animals – Navy):

- Fussy cut (10) 3 ¼" squares each centered on an animal.

Fabric J (1351-Pigment White Just Color! – Pigment White), cut:

- (2) 1 ⅜" x WOF strips, sub-cut (20) 1 ⅜" x 3 ¼" strips.
- (3) 1 ⅜" x WOF strips, sub-cut (20) 1 ⅜" x 5" strips.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5" x 5 ⅝" strips.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5" x 10 ¼" strips.

Fabric K (4185-77 Fishing Penguins – Navy), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 5" squares.

Backing (4186-70 Folksy Words – White/Blue), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 56" x 65" to make the back.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.
2. Sew (1) $1\frac{3}{8}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric I square. Sew (1) $1\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5 " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (10) Block Two squares total.
3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric E square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 blocks total.
4. Sew (1) Fabric D triangle to each side of (1) Unit 1 block to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.

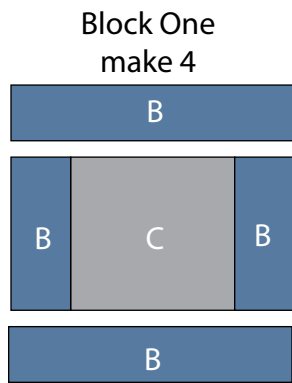

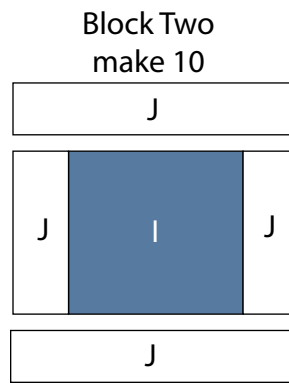

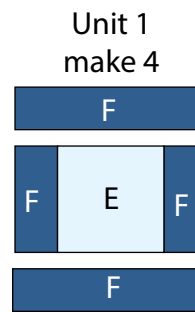

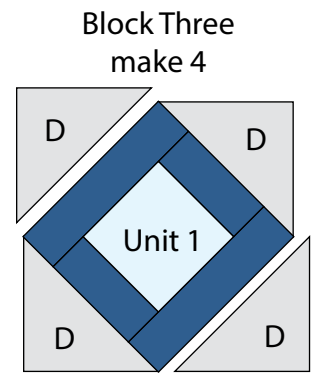

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow Figure 5 and the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

5. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $28\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 " x $28\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric A strip. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 22 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $13\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Three square to make (1) Side Strip. Repeat to make a second Side Strip. Sew (1) Side strip to each side of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Block Three square. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the new strip to make the Top Strip. Repeat to make the Bottom Strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $41\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 " x $33\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 5" x 5 5/8" Fabric J strip, (1) 5" Fabric K square, (1) Block Two square, (1) 5" Fabric H square, (1) Block Two square, (1) 5" Fabric H square, (1) Block Two square, (1) 5" Fabric K square and (1) 5" x 5 5/8" Fabric J strip together in that order to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) 5" Fabric H square. Sew (1) 5" Fabric K square to each end of the new strip. Sew (1) 5" x 10 1/4" Fabric J strip to each end of the new strip to make Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. Sew the borders to the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 51 1/4" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

13. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

14. Refer to the quilt layout to arrange and press (1) Fabric F Snowflake onto each Fabric J corner of the Center Block. (Note each snowflake will need to be trimmed to match the layout.)

15. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the quilt top.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

16. Press the quilt top and 56" x 65" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

17. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

18. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

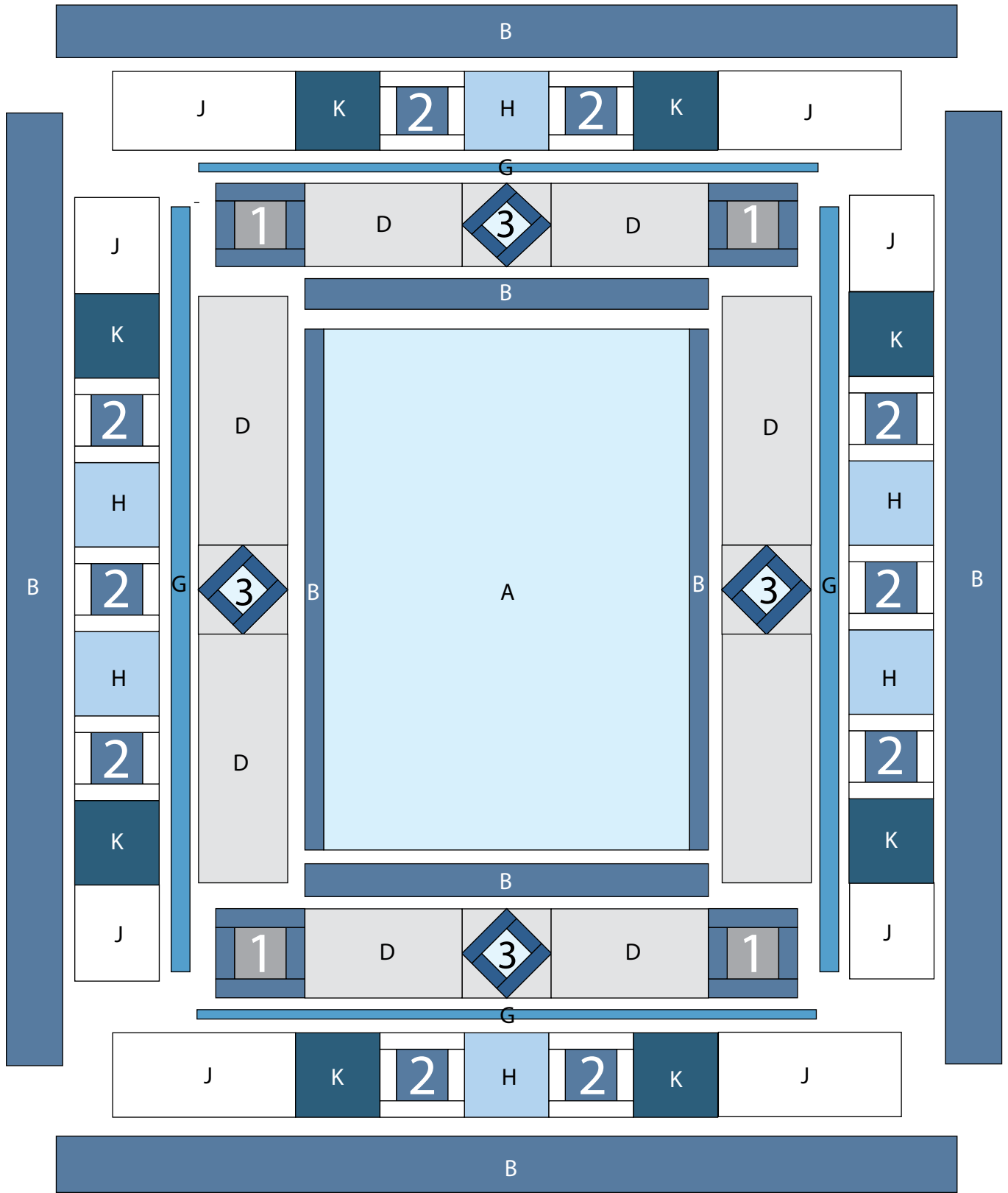
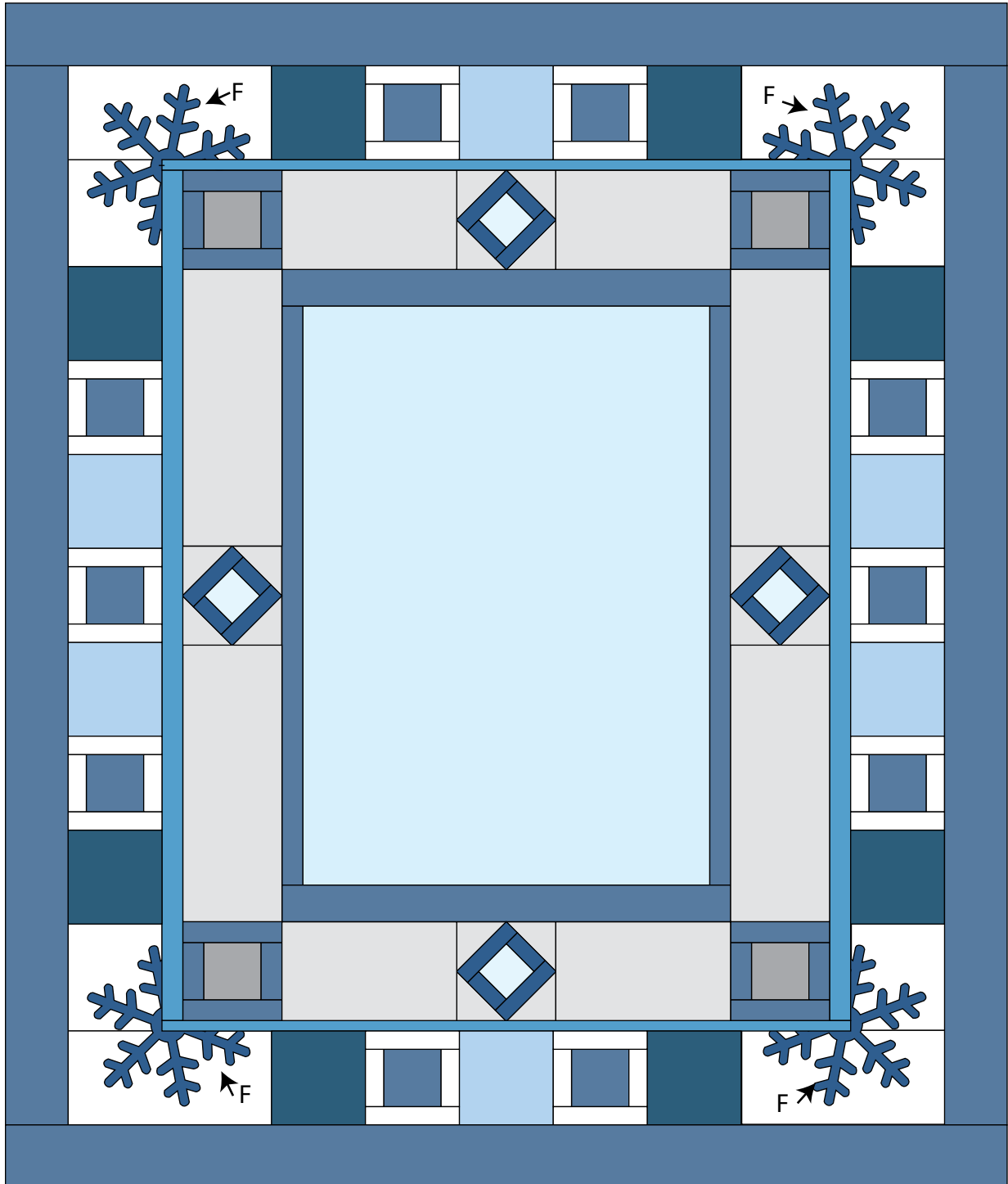


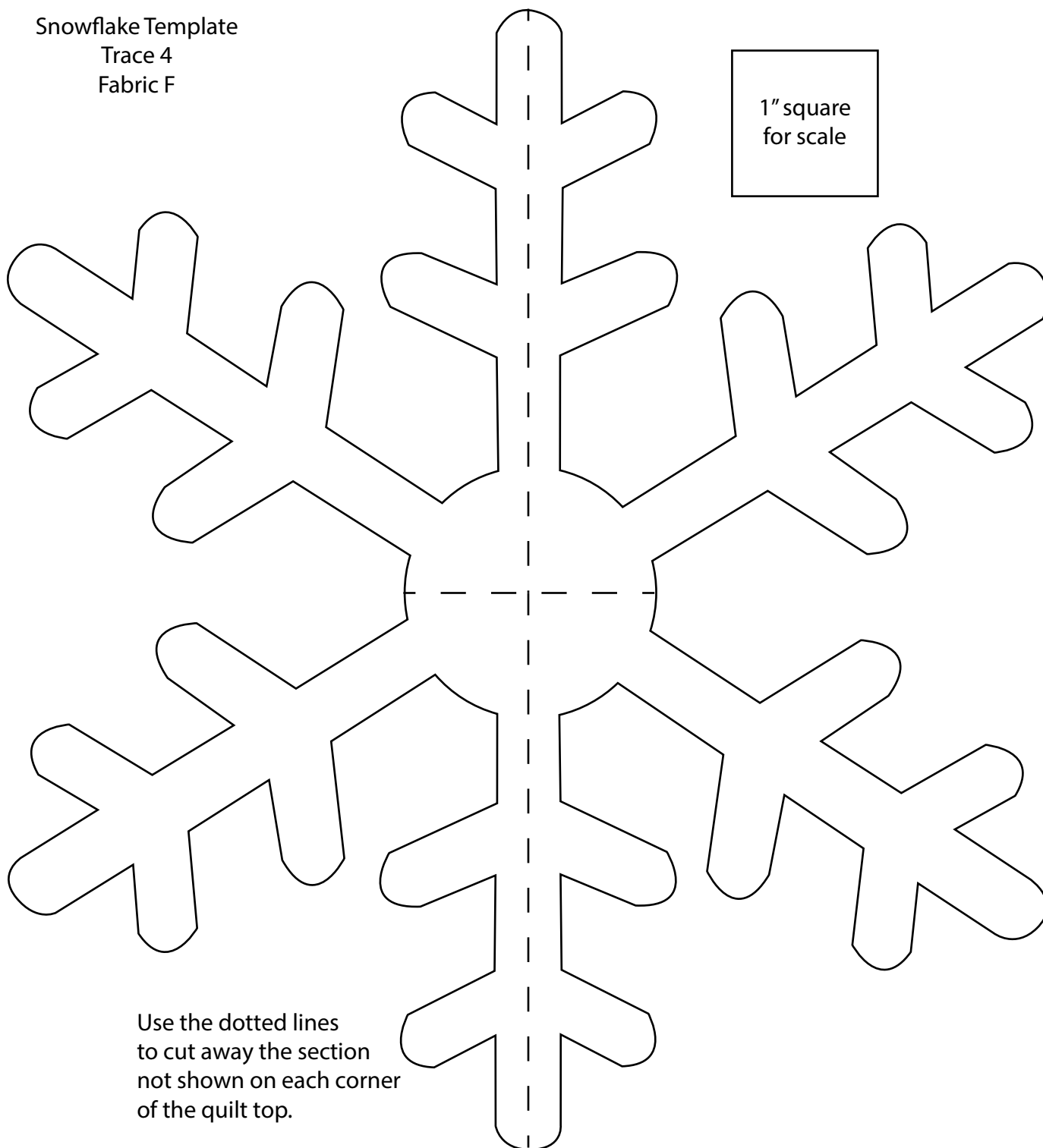
